

Additional instructions

1. Separate stickers should be filled out for each control structure that will be managed. For example, in a bioreactor there would usually be two stickers required, one for the inlet structure and one for the outlet structure.
2. The seasons/time periods identified in the colored boxes generally relate to the below months, but every location and management plan differ. Check your specific management plan to verify the stop log settings, inches from the top, and times of year. In general:
 - a. **Non-growing season** settings are for November to February
 - b. **The Spring and Fall settings** will be for two weeks prior to planting or harvesting, if the fall is wet.
 - c. **The Growing season** settings will be for March to October
3. A higher number written in (that is, more inches from the structure top) generally corresponds with fewer stop logs because the stop log setting will be shorter in the structure.
4. Use a knife or screwdriver to punch out the appropriate number of stop logs to achieve the given setting.
